ACUM is one of the flagship international academic conferences organized by the Faculty of Sociology and Communication and brings together interdisciplinary perspectives from sociology, communication and media studies, organizational studies, human resource management, anthropology, social work, and related fields.

The 2026 edition of the conference will focus on the broad theme of:

Participants are invited to submit their abstracts to one of the thematic panels published on the conference website. If a submission does not fit clearly within any of the listed sections, authors may submit their abstract under the general category: *Varia / Open Topics*

We welcome theoretical, empirical, methodological, and interdisciplinary contributions addressing contemporary societal transformations.

Submission Guidelines

Participants are invited to submit abstracts of maximum 500 words (excluding references).

Abstracts should clearly outline:

- the purpose of the paper
- theoretical framework
- methodology (if applicable)
- main findings or expected contribution

Submissions should be made through the conference submission platform available on the conference website.

Proposal Evaluation

Submissions will be evaluated based on:

- Relevance to conference themes

- Academic quality and innovation
- Clarity and coherence
- Interdisciplinary potential
- Contribution to scholarly dialogue

- Notification of Acceptance: 1–15 September 2026
- Registration and Fee Payment: 16 September – 20 October 2026
- Conference Dates: 4–7 November 2026
